Our savior, Jesus, has told us in Luke 19:10, "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Jesus made this statement after the interaction with Zacchaeus and a crowd. Jesus was going through Jericho and Zacchaeus, the tax collector, wanted to see Jesus but he could not due to the size of the crowd. So, being small in stature, he climbed a tree to see Jesus. Jesus sees him in the tree, calls him to come down, tells him he must stay at his house, and Zachaeus received him joyfully in response.

Of course, the crowd did not handle this well. Luke 19:7, "And when they saw it, they all grumbled, 'He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner'." In response Zacchaeus says he will give half of his goods to the poor, and if he has defrauded anyone, he will restore it two-fold. Jesus declares in verse 9, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham." As we have seen in Galatians 3:7, "Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham." Zacchaeus had faith, and our savior declared salvation. Then he follows that statement with v. 10, "for the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Praise the Lord.

Now, as ambassadors for Christ, we make this appeal, "We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God." (2 Cor. 5:20). This is our call brothers and sisters. We have been commissioned, called to go to the world and proclaim Christ (Matt. 28:18-20). Of course this is done in international missions, but this is also a call for us to image the savior in seeking the lost so that our Lord may save. Jesus says in Matt. 12:30, "Whoever is not with me is against me, and whoever does not gather with me scatters." Let us seek to be a church that gathers with our Lord, not scatter. Let us be a church that is with our Lord. May the Lord give us grace to gather as we make our appeal to the lost!


