

Why does Mt. Olive Baptist Church exist? I am not talking about the historic background of our church, nor am I talking about the material possessions that make up a church. I am talking about purpose. What is the purpose for Mt. Olive's existence? Why are we here? I would submit that the answer to that question is to make disciples. We see it in the "Great Commission" found in Matthew 28:18–20. "And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." We also see it in Acts 1:8, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Of course these two passages were given to specific people. However, I believe that the church finds its purpose here by extension. This is why Mt. Olive exists. We exist to make disciples at home and abroad. Notice that it is not just converts we are called to make. It is disciples. We are to raise up others to be more like Jesus. We do this first, by sharing the gospel with others through personal evangelism. Tell others about Jesus. The first thing that I would like for all of Mt. Olive to do in the process of disciple-making is to pray. Pray intentionally for someone that you know to come to saving faith. Then don't stop at prayer. Yes, prayer is essential. But, we also need to seek opportunities to share the gospel with people, invite them to church, and encourage them to come to Jesus. Who will you be praying for to come to faith throughout the next year?

But, we don't want to stop there. We want them to be discipled! Once the Lord saves the one that you are praying for, disciple them. A great place to start is the book of Mark. Study the book of Mark with someone, and expose them to Jesus quickly and often. Help them grow to be more like the Savior that they read about through "teaching them to observe all that I [Jesus] have commanded you." We are to help one another grow in our knowledge of the Savior and to put that knowledge into action.

Brothers and sisters, Mt. Olive exists to glorify God through making disciples. Let us be about what our Father would have us be about!


